A New Canvass

Based on the book of Genesis, what can you say about God, and how we relate to Him?

Under God...Over...From...For...do any of these sound like how you relate to God? Or ways you've heard God described by others?

In the Bible, how has God shown Himself to be with us? How about in your own experience? Would you say He is with you?

Introducing Moses: Political Activist & Exiled Shepherd

How has Israel's situation changed, since Genesis?

How did Moses's life change, in Exodus 1-2?

Introducing I AM: The God Who is With us

Based on Moses's interactions with God, how would you describe God's nature and character? (3:1-10)

Moses asks, "who am I?" (11) and "who are You? (13) – what can we learn about God, from His answers to these questions?

A Third Way: Humble Obedience

Based on Moses's continued questions (4:1-13), how has his character changed? Why would God use Him now?

Think about Moses's story – do you relate to any parts of it? Have you received a calling from God? How has He prepared you for it?

During this Lent season, is there a way in which you can create space in your life, for God to speak? If you're afraid of what He might say, remember, from Moses's story, that He prepares and equips you for any task.
