Luke 19:11-27: The Coming Kingdom

Nearing Jerusalem (19:11)

If you are a **follower** of Jesus, what did you expect?

What was in it for you?
Was it about making this life better, or investing in the next?

What do you expect of God's kingdom – His activity in this world?

- Do we expect to be on the "winning team" now, or are you hanging on and hoping in the future?

The King is Away (19:12-14)

Have you ever felt that God is **distant**?

- Have you felt **burdened** by the responsibility to do God's work, change people's lives, change the world, or even just to hang on and be faithful while waiting?
- Does it ever feel that God's team isn't winning and that we're **frustrated** by setbacks on all sides?

The King is Coming (19:15-27)

What do we really <u>believe</u> about God?

- Is it actually <u>worth</u> following Jesus? Do we trust that He sees and rewards His servants?
- Or is it better to cling to what's yours & take care of yourself?

Living in Anticipation

What do our actions say about where our hope is?
